### Position Description

The Community Engagement Intern will support Casa de Esperanza's community engagement team in domestic violence prevention efforts. The intern will assist with outreach efforts for a Youth Conference and engage in conversations about healthy relationships on a youth-led planning committee. The intern will have the opportunity to mentor youth in a weekly-run arts program, and engage in community events and trainings related to gender-based violence and domestic violence.

### Responsibilities:

- Co-facilitate conversations about leadership and healthy relationships with youth in preparation for Youth Conference
- Co-facilitate conversations about healthy masculinity and support implementation of boys circles
- Support Youth Conference planning in all aspects and solicit donations and resources to support the conference
- If time allows, teach art projects and facilitate healthy conversations with youth alongside other volunteers in Free Arts program

- Bilingual Spanish/English preferred but not required
